

OBSERVATION

Examination: MRI Cervical Spine

Clinical indication: No known injury. Neck pain.

Findings:

At the C3-4 level, a shallow central disc protrusion is present. No high grade neural foraminal narrowing or central spinal stenosis.

At the C4-5 level, a left paracentral disc protrusion is present. No high grade neural foraminal narrowing or central spinal stenosis.

At the C5-6 level, disc space narrowing and shallow bilateral spondylotic protrusions are present with a shallow central disc protrusion. No high grade neural foraminal narrowing or central spinal stenosis.

No evidence of disc herniation or protrusion. No high grade neural foraminal narrowing or central stenosis at any level.

The cord signal is unremarkable with no evidence of demyelination, myelomalacia, or myelitis.

The marrow signal is unremarkable

IMPRESSION

1. C3-4: Shallow central disc protrusion.
2. C4-5: Shallow left paracentral disc protrusion.
3. C5-6: Bilateral spondylotic protrusions and shallow central disc protrusion. No high grade neural foraminal narrowing or central stenosis at this or any level.
4. No evidence of cord signal abnormality. Please see body of report for further details.
